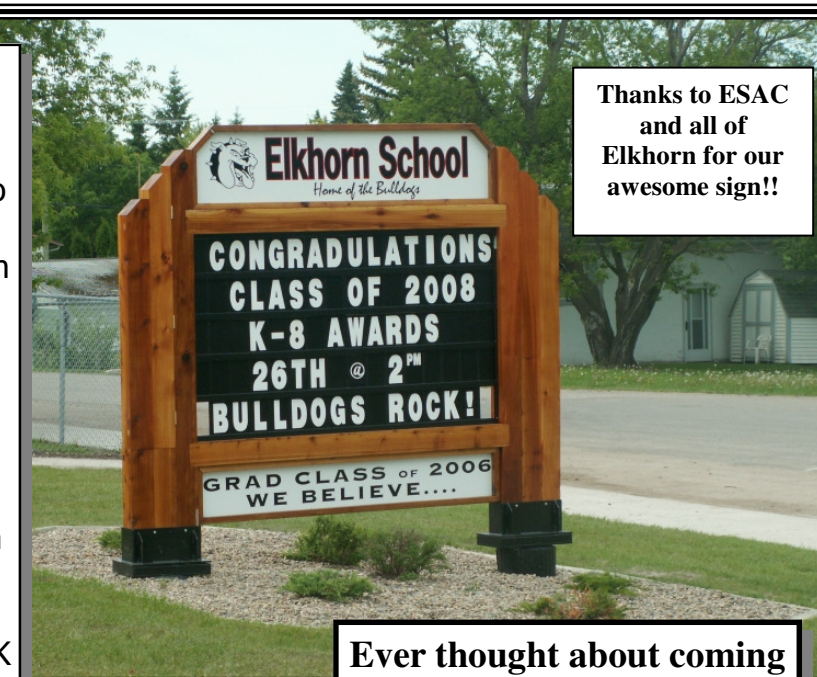


WE'LL MISS:

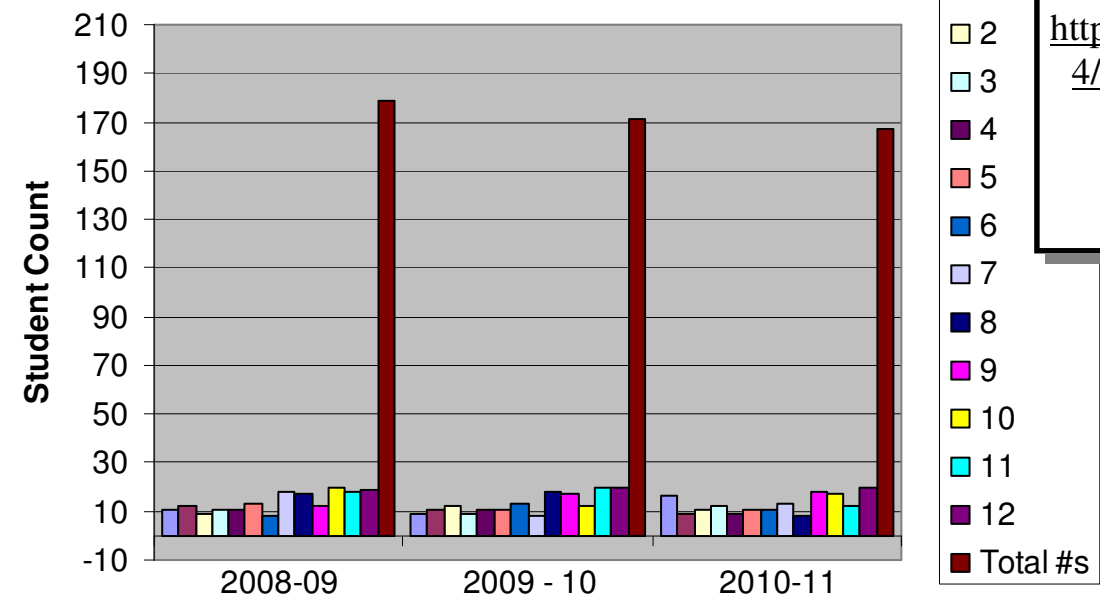
