Territorial Extent of the Division

Upon the establishment and incorporation of the Fort La Bosse School Division in 1959, the Division consisted of five wards.

By-Law No. 2/72 expanded the number of wards from five to nine.

By-Law No. 3/2002 reduced the number of wards from nine to four.

By-Law No. 3/2002 expanded the number of wards from four to five.

The number of wards and the boundaries thereof, as stated by By-Law No. 2/2007, shall be set out as:

Ward One shall consist of:

All of the property within the boundaries of the Town of Virden.

Ward Two shall consist of:

a) All that portion of the Rural Municipality of Ellice-Archie that are within the Fort La Bosse School Division.

b) All that portion of the Rural Municipality of Wallace-Woodworth west and north of the Trans Canada Highway #1 and on the west side of P.T.H. #83, and south from Trans Canada Highway #1 Down and into the Rural Municipality of Pipestone to a point at the southeast corner of Section 2, Township 10, Range 27 and all west to the Saskatchewan border.

c) The LUD of Elkhorn.

Ward Three shall consist of:

a) All of the Rural Municipality of Pipestone with the exception of Township 9 east of P.T.H. #83 and also that portion of the Rural Municipality of Two Borders that is within the Fort La Bosse School Division.

Ward Four shall consist of:

- a) All of the Rural Municipality of Sifton and the Rural Municipality of Wallace-Woodworth that are within the Fort La Bosse School Division.
- b) All that portion of the Rural Municipality of Pipestone east of P.T.H. #83 and in Township 9 and Range 26.
- c) All that portion of the Rural Municipality of Whitehead that is within the Fort La Bosse School Division.
- d) All that portion of the Rural Municipality of Wallace-Woodworth surrounding the Town of Virden and bordering the Rural Municipality of Sifton and the Rural Municipality of Wallace-Woodworth to the east, and then west to P.T.H. #83 north of the Town of Virden, and then west and south of the Town of Virden from the northwest corner of Section 6, Township 11, Range 26 south to the Southwest corner of Section 1, Township 10, Range 26, and east to P.T.H. #83.
- e) The Town of Oak Lake.

Ward Five shall consist of:

- a) All of Canupawakpa Dakota Nation
