The number of Trustees elected by the qualified electors in each ward, as prescribed by By-Law No. 3/2002 of the Fort La Bosse School Division will form a total of nine trustees and be divided as follows:

Ward One	- Three trustees
Ward Two	- Two trustees
Ward Three	- Two trustees
Ward Four	- Two trustees

A Trustee, once elected, will normally hold that office for a period of four years.

Section 10 of the Local Authorities Election Act provides for the appointment of:

- an enumerator
- a revising officer
- a returning officer

Such persons will hold office until they die, resign, or are removed from office by a legal judicial process.

When a vacancy occurs in the office of enumerator, revising officer, or returning officer by reason of death, resignation, or any other cause, the Board will forthwith appoint a person to fill the vacancy.
