The Board of the Fort La Bosse School Division believes that the legislation of policies is the most important function of a School Board, and that the execution of the policies should be the function of the Superintendent, with the aid of the Administrative Officers.

Delegation by the Board of its executive powers to the Superintendent provides freedom for the Superintendent to manage the schools within the Board's policies, and frees the Board to devote its time to policy making and appraisal functions.

The Board holds the Superintendent responsible for carrying out its policies within established guidelines and for keeping the Board informed about school operations.

In order to keep the Board informed, the Superintendent will notify Board members as promptly as possible of any happenings of an emergency nature that occur in schools.
