For reasons of enhancing the safety and security of all persons (students, community members, staff) on school division property and deterring destructive acts, the Board authorizes the use of video surveillance equipment on school division property where circumstances have shown that it is necessary for these purposes and the benefits of using such outweigh the impact on the privacy of those observed.

In dealing with the surveillance of school division property, the Board recognizes both its legal obligation to provide appropriate levels of supervision in the interest of the safety of all persons on school division property and the fact that all individuals on school division property have privacy rights that are reduced but not eliminated while on school division property. All of this supervision must be carried out in a manner which respects everyone's privacy rights.

Video surveillance is to be carried out in accordance with this policy and regulations. Any technology used for taking of still or moving pictures including, without restricting the generality of the foregoing, video or digital cameras shall be encompassed by this policy. The Board will take appropriate actions in the event that any video surveillance is carried out contrary to this policy and these procedures.
