Any student in regular attendance in a school within the Fort la Bosse School Division and residing a distance of more than 1.6 kilometres (one mile) from their appropriate school within their catchment area will be transported by the Division.

As a courtesy service, students residing 1.6 kilometres (one mile) or closer to a school within their catchment area may ride a school bus to and from home and school provided:

- there is adequate room on the bus.
- the bus has time within its route schedule to stop and pick up students.
- the bus does not leave its designated route to pick up or drop off students.
- students are prepared to comply with the Division's school bus regulations.
- the passenger size and capacity of the buses will not be increased to accommodate the courtesy service.

Students who attend schools outside the catchment area may ride a school bus traveling to the student's choice of school provided:

- there is adequate room on the bus.
- the bus has time within its route schedule to stop and pick up the student.
- the bus does not travel off route to pick up or drop off the student.

Any student in regular attendance in a school within the Fort La Bosse School Division will meet the school bus at the end of their respective lane provided the lane is .8 kilometres (1/2 mile) or less in length.

Provision will also be made to transport those students who are unable to walk to school because of physical or other handicaps.
