The Board of Trustees may authorize the use of a school bus:

1. to transport students for the purpose of participating in or attending extracurricular activities or field trips.
2. to transport Trustees and Division staff members carrying out specified duties.
3. to transport the vehicle as may be required for the purpose of repairing or servicing.

A school bus may be used for the purposes outlined in items 1. and 2. above, only when:

- the use has been approved by the Board or a person designated by the Board;
- there is at all times, in full force and effect, insurance coverage in an amount satisfactory to the Minister, providing for the payment of damages for the injury to, or the death of, one or more persons, including any passengers, and those persons mentioned above in items 1. and 2. above, and for the payment of damages arising from loss or damage to property;
- it is driven by a qualified driver in accordance with the Highway Traffic Act and P.S.A. P250; and
- other than for instructional purposes, the students to be transported are accompanied in the school bus by a supervisor approved by the School Principal, or designate.

Requests received from non-Division (public) sources must have the approval of the Manitoba Motor Transit Board, Manitoba Public Insurance Corporation and Board of Trustees before they may be assigned for travel.
