The implementation of efficient record management, particularly in light of technological change, enable divisions to discharge their responsibilities to ensure both access and protection of information. Fort La Bosse School Division accepts as policy the practices and procedures outlined in the Government of Manitoba Guidelines on the Retention and Disposition of School Division/District Records and Manitoba Public Fine Guidelines, and shall ensure compliance with the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FIPPA) and the Personal Health Information Act (PHIA).

The following policies and procedures are designed to comply with the policy requirements of The Personal Health Information Act respecting collection, use, disclosure, security, retention and destruction of personal health information.
