The Co-operative Work Experience Program is a valuable component in the preparing of students for their transition to the workplace.

The Co-operative Work Experience Program requires the development of a series of partnerships between the school and business or industry. Acting in consort, the venture will provide an organised sequence of work experiences that combine classroom instruction and related part-time practice at a worksite. The owner(s)/manager of each proposed student worksite must complete a worksite agreement with the Board before a student(s) may be assigned to that location.

Co-operative work experience will be supervised and evaluated by a combination of the following individuals as the situation dictates:

- teacher/co-ordinator
- the employer
- school administrator

All proposed Co-operative Work Experience locations must complete a work site agreement (**IHAQ-E**) with the Board before a student(s) may be assigned to the station.

All students enrolled in a work education program must be registered with The Worker's Compensation Board before they begin the worksite experience section of the program.

Students may drive to a Co-operative Work Experience site only after they have an acceptable form (**EEAG-E**) on file at their school office. However, students driving to and from the worksite will not transport other students in their vehicle.
