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HSAP EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENTS

- 1. As a participant in the HSAP program, you are representing not only yourself, but also your school and division. This is a privilege. Therefore, it is expected that you will conduct yourself respectfully and responsibly at all times on the worksite and in any dealings related to your placement.*
- 2. It is very strongly recommended that you attend a workplace safety presentation such as "Workers of Tomorrow" before commencing your job placement. Another alternative might be to study an on-line workplace safety program.*
- 3. Students are responsible for ensuring that the appropriate paperwork has been completed and the \$50 registration fee has been submitted with their application.*
- 4. It is strongly recommended that the student conduct a "safety audit" with their employer to outline potential hazards and appropriate safety measures for their specific work environment. This should be done at the start of their employment.*
- 5. REMEMBER – In Manitoba, the law states:*
 - a. Workers have the "Right to know" about dangers in the work environment.*
 - b. Workers have the "Right to Participate" in the day-to-day detection, evaluation and reduction of workplace hazards.*
 - c. Workers have the "Right to Refuse" to work in conditions known or believed to be dangerous.*
