While the Board believes in the merits of the public education system it also recognises the right of parents to home school their children.

The Division does not have any role or responsibility in either the approval or operation of home schooling situations that are allowed to operate within its geographic boundaries. In order to be considered for home schooling, a parent must complete and forward the required registration material to the Home Schooling Office of Manitoba Education. Further requirements of parents who have their home schooling application accepted include an annual comprehensive educational plan and regular progress reports.

Parents of children who are being home schooled may make arrangements with their catchment area school to have their home-schooled son(s)/daughter(s) attend school for those parts of the educational program that the parent believes would best serve the needs of each child. Any such request must, however, fit within the time schedule for classes that the school follows and be acceptable to the School Principal.

Furthermore, the parent may, at mutually agreed appropriate times, decide to discontinue their home schooling program and enrol their son(s)/daughter(s) in either their designated Fort La Bosse school or a School of Choice. (Form [JFB-E](#))
