The Board encourages the development of programs that reflect the unique educational needs of the schools and/or the individual students under its jurisdiction. The Board recognizes the advantages that such courses may offer for our students but, in doing so, expects that all submitted proposals will be supported within the parameters of projected school budgetary allocations.

Schools that decide to offer a School Initiated Course or allow a student to enrol in a Student Initiated Project may either develop their own course outline or “acquire” a previously approved program. In all such cases, the Manitoba Education requirements for course approval and annual registration must be obtained if a credit is to be awarded upon the successful completion of the program. Furthermore, all SICs and SIPs must receive the approval of the Principal, the Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment Consultant, the Superintendent and the Board before being forwarded to Manitoba Education for approval and registration.
