In response to the increasing demand for adult upgrading opportunities the Board has established the Fort La Bosse Adult Learning Centre (FLAC).

FLAC will offer high school credit courses for adult students nineteen (19) years of age and older. The program will be designed and presented to meet the basic educational program requirements for students who:

- have experienced a disrupted or inconsistent schooling experience
- require a flexible and individualised learning environment
- aspire to completing a high school program

The curriculum for the courses offered at FLAC will be congruent with Manitoba Education standards and outcomes, with limited adaptations made as necessitated by individual student needs and abilities. Adult students seeking graduation status will be directed to the Mature Student Diploma unless it is to their advantage to complete their original high school credit requirements. All FLAC students who enrol in a course in which there is a provincial assessment component will have their Manitoba Education exam score included when their final mark is being calculated.

FLAC will provide the necessary textbooks and resources. The student will be responsible for personal work materials and any related course fees that may be levied at the time of enrolment. Students will also be responsible for their own transportation to and from the FLAC site.

Students who satisfy the graduation requirements for the program in which they are enrolled may participate in the graduation exercises of Virden Collegiate Institute. Graduating students will be eligible to participate in the convocation exercises that immediately follow the successful completion of their program.

FLAC and its programs will be subject to periodic review and evaluation.
