All students working towards high school credits are expected to put forth time and effort in each course. The teacher and/or the Principal will advise students who have ability but are indifferent and repeatedly fail to apply themselves to their courses that no credit will be given at the end of the semester.

Steps to be followed leading to denial of credit are:

- a) Subject teacher informs student and parent(s) of the laggard status.
- b) If the laggard problem is not cleared up, the teacher will advise the Principal and the case will be reviewed. The student and parent(s) will meet with the Principal and teacher.
- c) If the laggard problem continues the student and parent(s) may be formally advised of the loss of credit.
