The schools in the Fort La Bosse School Division consider regular student attendance important and all students are expected to attend regularly.

Although high school courses will not generally use attendance as a consideration in course evaluation, it is accepted that each student's participation in the day to day activities of a course through regular attendance is critical to maximise the learning experience.

For that reason, within the provisions of the regulations outlined on the following pages, a student may be withdrawn from a high school course for excessive unexcused absences.

Parents should give careful consideration prior to authorising an absence from a class for their child. Even though the need to be absent may seem important, parents are asked to determine if the absence is absolutely necessary as regular student attendance enhances student achievement.
