All “residents” under the age of twenty-one (21) years at the beginning of the school year, and not otherwise disqualified, have the right to enrol at their designated Fort La Bosse school.

A resident student means a student:

- whose parent or legal guardian with whom he resides is a resident of the School Division.
- who has attained the age of 18 years and is a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant, as defined in the Immigration Act (Canada), and resident within the School Division.
- who by reason of being dealt with under any provision of the Child and Family Services Act or the Young Offenders Act is a resident of the School Division.
- who is designated in writing by the Minister as a resident of the School Division.
