Non-resident students may be admitted to a Division school under the following conditions:

- accommodation must be available
- application for admission will be made to the Superintendent for approval of the Board
- required fees are either paid or acceptable payment arrangements are in place
- Principals of schools will admit non-resident students only on the authority of the Board
- permits are valid only for the school year for which they are issued
- where there is doubt as to the status of the student, the case should be referred to the Superintendent for decision
- where there are compassionate grounds, applications may be made to the Board to admit non-resident students without the payment of fees
- there are no other reasons or known conditions which would cause the student to be ineligible for consideration for enrolment

Non-resident students may be admitted only to the school to which they are assigned. Admission to any school in any year will not constitute grounds for admission to the same or to any other school in subsequent years;
