Calculation of Non-Resident Fees

The non-resident fee for students in the regular instruction program will be based on the actual cost of education less non-shareable costs and offset revenue. The fee will be calculated on a year-to-year basis based on the budget for each year and pro-rated based on the annual course load of the student, as follows:

- One-quarter of the annual fee will be charged if the student's annual course load is 220 hours or less;
- One-half of the annual fees will be charged if the student's annual course load is more than 220 hours but less than 440 hours; or
- The full annual fee will be charged if the student's annual course load is greater than 439 hours.

Further costs for non-resident students may include:

- The non-resident fee for students utilising the Division's transportation system will be calculated with transportation costs and revenue included; and/or
- The non-resident fee for students who are enrolled in special needs programs, vocational programs, community education programs or students who require support or resources not normally provided in the regular instruction program, will be adjusted to reflect the additional costs of these programs, support and resources.

Method of Payment

The Division will determine the method of payment of the non-resident fee. The Division may accept differing terms of payment, but in no case will these be less than monthly over the school term.
