RE: Restorative Justice Circle

Fort La Bosse School Division expects that all students act in a responsible and safe manner while in attendance at school. In accordance with policy JICH – students who have failed to do so twice, are recommended for expulsion, unless they are identified as candidates for a Restorative Justice Circle.

You have been identified as being a candidate for a Circle.

The purpose of your Circle is for you to meet the people whom their actions have most impacted, and hear the community wide consequences for your irresponsible and unsafe actions. In the end, you will be asked to choose a couple of mentors from within the Circle; one, from your family or community, and the other, from the school or division. Your work will be to meet with the mentors regularly and explore your learning as a result of your decisions which brought you to this place, and then demonstrate such back to the Circle when we reconvene in six (6) weeks time.

Your Circle has been set for date at time. It will be located in the location room.

The participants of the Circle will include representation of the community, the division, the school, an elder, AFM worker, and your parents. These people are asked to meet 15 minutes prior to the start of the Circle.

You will be expected to re-enter school on date following the circle, after meeting with intake people. Please make arrangements for this meeting after the Circle.

Should you become involved in any further discipline issues at the school, it will be expected that the School Administrators request your attendance privileges be revoked, and we will proceed with expulsion.
