Upon second offense of drug use, student be given the option to participate in a Restorative Justice Circle to avoid expulsion, if criteria are met.

CRITERIA TO CONSIDER:

Age of student

Number of infractions to JICH or JK in current school year, and previous years

Current academic success, in relation to previous success

Relationship with school community

Willingness of student's advocate to participate and support the process

MUSTS:

Circle is to happen at the divisional level, as offering an alternative to expulsion is a Board directive. It will be facilitated by a consistent Divisional person who has the division's practice and history in his/her understanding.
