Students of the age of majority (18 or over), but under twenty-one (21) years of age, who have not completed a high school diploma will be admitted to the classes of a Division School. Furthermore, a student under the age of twenty-one (21) years of age, who has completed a high school diploma and is a resident of the Division, may enrol in up to a maximum of four (4) additional approved courses after the end of the school year in which graduation occurs without seeking Board approval prior to registration. All students who are under the age of twenty-one (21) years of age when they enrol in a regular high school class will do so subject to the same policies and regulations that govern other Fort La Bosse high school students.

Students who are of the age of majority have the right to control the access to their personal information. Any sharing of marks or other personal data of a student who is eighteen (18) years of age or older may be done only with the written agreement of the student.
