The Board encourages and supports Student Social Events including school dances. When school dances are held the guidelines will include that:

1. The maximum number of dances that a school can hold in any one school year will be subject to local decision;
2. The latest date that any of these dances will be held must be prior to the last day of classes in June;
3. All dances will have chaperones who will be teachers and parents, the latter being the responsibility of the students to recruit;
4. All school dances will be closed to the public;*
5. Students will be responsible for the behaviour of their guests;
6. The drinking of alcohol immediately prior to or during a school dance will not be allowed and any student(s) under the apparent influence of alcohol at the dance will be reported to their parents and/or the police;
7. Students drinking alcohol, or deemed to be under the influence of alcohol or other mind-altering drug, will be released only to their parents, another responsible adult family member or the RCMP;
8. All school dances will end not later than 1:00 A.M.

* However, students may bring guests provided the guest's name appears on an approved guest list not later than 12 noon on the day of the dance. The guest list requires the approval of the Principal or designate.
