Fort La Bosse School Division provides clinical services focused on assessment and intervention to the students of the school division. These services may be provided by employees of the division, by employees of divisions and agencies with which we have a Shared Services Agreement or, on a fee for service or contract basis.

Clinicians are an integral part of the educational team and are to be included in determining programming and drafting; funding applications, classroom based support plans, Individual Education Plans (IEP's), Behaviour Intervention Plans (BIP's) for students on their caseload.

Clinicians are under the immediate supervision of the Co-ordinator of Student Services as well as the Principal of the school in which the clinician is working. The clinician will report assessment results and related information to the Co-ordinator of Student Services.

Where division staff is not available, psychology, OT & PT, speech, reading and other clinical services may be contracted on a fee for service basis.

All clinical services provided in Fort La Bosse School Division are governed by: procedures as outlined in the Student Services Handbook, Role descriptions of Clinical Services personnel and the standards and guidelines set by professional organizations for their members.
