The Board anticipates that for the majority of time on most school days the students will come under the direct authority and supervision of a teacher and a school principal. It is also understood that at certain times, for a variety of educational needs and/or school-related events, the supervision of students may be shared with other adults.

Persons having care and charge of students will:

- be a responsible adult(s).
- be subject to the Act and the instruction of the School Board.
- come under direct supervision of a teacher designated by the Principal of the school to which they are assigned.

Such persons may be:

- school social workers, school psychologists, or speech and hearing pathologists.
- teacher assistants or other persons approved by the Minister employed by school authorities.
- designated persons working with teachers and students as part of the teaching/learning process - in this regulation called para-professionals.
- student teachers.
- volunteers.

The designated school bus driver(s) will not act as a supervisor on any extra-curricular or field trip to which he is assigned.

During school hours, students will be assigned to a properly supervised room. During recess and noon hour, the Principal, in conjunction with the staff, will organise a schedule of supervision.

Supervision of students in the school after school hours will be maintained by those authorised.
