Students in Fort La Bosse high schools over the age of sixteen (16) may seek to enrol in the High School Apprenticeship Option program. Any student who is accepted into the program will be subject to the guidelines as established by Manitoba Education.

The High School Apprenticeship Option is:

- an extension and enhancement of regular apprenticeship training.
- an access route to a training process in trades facing skill shortages.
- open and flexible.
- available to students in participating Senior Years schools.
- an integration of instructional education and the workplace.

Students who wish to acquire credit(s) under the HSAP may be required to arrange their own worksite. All HSAP sites must, however, be approved by the Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment Coordinator who will assist with the sign-up process and will liaison with the student/school/parent/Manitoba Apprenticeship Branch and employer.

Students who succeed in obtaining a placement under the HSAP must be covered by Workers Compensation before they enter the worksite. As an employee, the employer is responsible for providing Workers Compensation and any accidents on the worksite should be reported to the FLB Assessment Coordinator.

A student, who has been granted permission (Form [EEAG-E](#)), may drive to their workstation, however, students driving to and from the worksite will not transport other students in their vehicle.

The Board acknowledges that a HSAP student will receive a regulated wage at a rate related to the trade of choice for the hours worked. The Board will not, however, accept either responsibility or liability for any kind or sort of misfortune(s) related to the workplace. The onus of evaluating the suitability and safety of the workplace and quality and effectiveness of worksite supervision will be that of the student and his parents/guardian(s).
